One crew replaced a very badly aged roof and the other two worked on decks and ramps so that the residents could safely navigate in and out of their homes.



Every year the cost of the trip runs over \$10,000. Much of the cost of the trip is covered by those going on the trip. Historically we have asked Bethel to help cover the cost of those that cannot afford the registration fee as well as the cost of renting the necessary work vehicles for the trip.
