Bethel United Church of Christ Leadership Council Meeting Summary October 20, 2024

Continuing Business:

- 1. Convergence update: The Vision Team will be meeting soon to plan for the future.
- 2. Personnel: Bethel is now offering a health care benefit called the Employer Care Program to its employees through Ascension St. Vincent. This program is at no cost to the church.
- 3. Lawsuit: As reported last month, two lawsuits have been filed against Bethel UCC on behalf of the two children that were sexually molested on our premises. There is no update from either our insurance company or from our attorney at this time. Our attorney expects these lawsuits to take 1 ¹/₂ to 2 years to resolve.
- 4. Council Nominations for 2025: We are still looking for a Vice President for 2025.
- 5. Sabbatical Grant Approved from the Lilly Foundation: Sam will be on sabbatical for June August of 2025. Initial plans are being made to provide coverage for the 3-month period.

New Business:

- 1. Membership: Larry Tindle has joined Bethel as a member.
- 2. Custodian: Christina Woywood was hired as the custodian.

We repent of any intentional and unintentional harm caused to the LGBTQIA+ community and individuals by our collective action and inaction; we ask for their forgiveness, and Gods, and seek to make tangible and intentional repair, in word and in deed.

We covenant to make institutional changes that reflect the diversity and inclusion that are at the heart of the Gospel and to align our bylaws, policies, procedures, and practices to be open to and affirming of the participation of all persons in the Christian faith, ministry, and service of our conference.

We promise to come alongside and stand together with the LGBTQIA+ community in ways that end marginalization, oppression, and exclusion.

We encourage the Officers, Board Members, and Staff of the Indiana-Kentucky Conference to advocate for the rights, support the needs, and affirm the inherent worth of LGBTQIA+ individuals.

We seek with continual curiosity, courage, and openness to learn how we may best serve God and God's creation in the future God has in store for us.

This we covenant with the Still-Speaking God in whom we live and move and have our being, Christ who has redeemed us for Love, and with the Holy Spirit who leads us ever forward in God's service.
