Bethel United Church of Christ Leadership Council Meeting Summary January 19, 2025

Continuing Business:

- 1. Convergence update: The Vision Team is planning to hold one meal a month after church in February and March to promote times of fellowship.
- 2. Lawsuit: We received official notice that our insurance company is denying coverage for the second claim of two claims against Bethel. Our lawyer is following up with the insurance provider that provides Errs and Omissions coverage to our insurance agent before any legal action is taken.
- 3. Council Nominations for 2025: Jenny Webster has agreed to serve as Vice President for 2025.
- 4. 2025 Budget. The budget for 2025 was approved to be sent to the congregation. Notable changes in the budget from the prior year: a 35% increase in liability insurance costs (the increase is \$13,930), we budgeted legal expenses of \$66,000 for the year, the positions of Nursery Attendants and the Youth Program Associate were eliminated, and the youth music program was not budgeted sue to the resignation of Abby Thomas.
- 5. Sabbatical: The Sabbatical committee will meet in February to begin making plans for the summer. Rev. Lynn Moreno has agreed to provide pastoral leadership during the Sabbatical.

New Business:

- 1. A new Fund Policy was adopted.
- 2. A new Conflict of Interest Policy was adopted.
- 3. The resignation of Abby Thomas was received and plans were made accordingly to end the musical program. The Personnel Committee agreed to pay Abby for one additional month from the date of her resignation. We also agreed to work with Abby to determine what she may want to take with her as she is hoping to continue a youth musical program on her own.

Thank you to everyone who joined us for our Annual Meeting! Your presence and input in approving the budget and leadership positions are truly valued. You can find links to our Annual Report in our "Thursday Updates" email. Together, we're strengthening the foundation of our church community, and we're excited for the opportunities ahead as we continue to grow in faith and service. Let's move forward, united in purpose, for another year of ministry and impact!
