Bethel United Church of Christ Leadership Council Meeting Summary May 18, 2025

Continuing Business:

- 1. Lawsuit: Lexington Insurance has agreed to defend the second case. They have still not agreed to indemnify the church for this case but will pay the cost of defense. We are still pursuing litigation for them to indemnify the church.
- 2. Sabbatical: Rev. Lynn Moreno will be filling in for Rev Buehrer while he is away in June August. A display will be posted in the Narthex. The following meals are being planned:
 - a. a) June 1- Picnic with sharing of what Rev. Buehrer will be doing while on Sabbatical as well as in introduction to Rev. Moreno.
 - b. b) July 24 CELEBRATE SUMMER! An Evening with Bethel Friends at Venue 812. This is a catered dinner followed by an evening of trivia. All costs paid for by the Lilly Foundation and supplemented by Bethel reserve funds if needed.
 - c. c) September 6 Rally Day and Homecoming Celebration Dinner
- 3. Youth Musical Program: We received the final check from Cur8. We may have a minor computer IT issue to resolve. Otherwise with the reception of this check all issues with ending the Youth Musical Program have been resolved.

New Business:

- 1. Preschool: We recently started enrolling children as young as 2 ½ years old. We are seeing the needed increased enrollment with this change. We will continue to monitor the enrollment issue closely to see if additional changes need to be made by late summer.
- 2. Sanctuary Roof replacement & Concrete ramp on main walk from parking lot to the Sanctuary. We are fund raising to cover the cost of replacing the roof (\$50,000) and cutting a ramp into the sidewalk (\$4,800). We have received around \$22,000 to date toward this fundraising. We have set a goal date of September 15 of completing the fundraising and replacing the roof.

Financials:

- 1. Our Operating Income is slightly ahead of budget and expenses are slightly below budget. We continue to watch the finances closely.
- 2. Bethel Buddies: Expenses are running slightly ahead of income. This is a trend we are watching closely since the State of Indiana has put their focus on having the public schools provide preschool. We have experienced a loss of students as a result of this change. With the change to enrolling 2 ½ year old's, we are hopeful that this will move us into a positive financial position in the near future.


