

Bethel United Church of Christ Leadership Council Meeting Summary October 19, 2025

Continuing Business:

- 1. Lawsuit: No Update
- 2. Sabbatical: The Pastor's Final Narrative Report has been completed as has the Final Financial Report. The Sabbatical Committee is scheduled to meet October 26 to draft the Final Congregation Report. Once these are completed, they will be submitted to the Lilly Foundation.
- 3. Sanctuary Roof & Sidewalk: Both are being scheduled for completion in the coming month or so.

New Business:

1. 2026 Budget Process: Work has begun on the 2026 budget.

Financials:

- 1. We are running a deficit YTD of \$36,892 to budget. Our income is short \$29,561 (Contributions primarily) while expenses are over budget by \$7,331(Utilities and computer upgrades). Ron Vogel will be sharing the financial concerns with the congregation.
- 2. Bethel Buddies: We are making every attempt to get the preschool operation in the black. We will be very close to doing so by the end of October. It has been a very difficult year of operation due to the many financial cuts that are being made by the State of Indiana as it is cutting support for preschool operations that support low income families.

CLEAN UP BUCKETS

We want to take a moment to express deep gratitude to each and every one of you who helped make our Disaster Relief Bucket drive a success. Because of your generosity, care, and willingness to serve, we were able to pack and deliver **36 Disaster Relief Buckets** to those in need.

Throughout the month of June, your donations steadily poured in—items both big and small that will now provide comfort and practical help to individuals and families facing hardship after disaster. In October, these buckets were delivered and are already on their way to making a difference in the lives of those who need it most.
