Bethel United Church of Christ Leadership Council Meeting Summary November 16, 2025

Continuing Business:


- 1. Lawsuit: No Update
- 2. Sabbatical: Work has begun on the draft of the Final Congregation Report. Once that is completed, we will begin submitting a report to the Lilly Foundation.
- 3. Sanctuary Roof & Sidewalk: The roof was completed. The sidewalk modification has yet to be scheduled.

New Business:

- 1. 2026 Budget Process: Work continues on the 2026 budget. A draft budget will be submitted to the Leadership Council at its December meeting.
- 2. We are following up on an outstanding invoice involving Dream Street Studio and MTI (a production company). This invoice should not have included Bethel UCC as we were not working with Dream Street Studio at the time of the purchase.

Financials:

- 1. Our income is behind budget \$39,267 year-to-date. (Contributions primarily) while expenses are over budget by \$11,943primarily due to unbudgeted computer upgrades and October having a third (additional) pay period. The ASP funds (\$6,684) were redesignated for Back bay Mission
- 2. Bethel Buddies: Enrollment continues to be a problem (entirely due to the State of Indiana cutting the funding for the voucher program for children of low income families).
